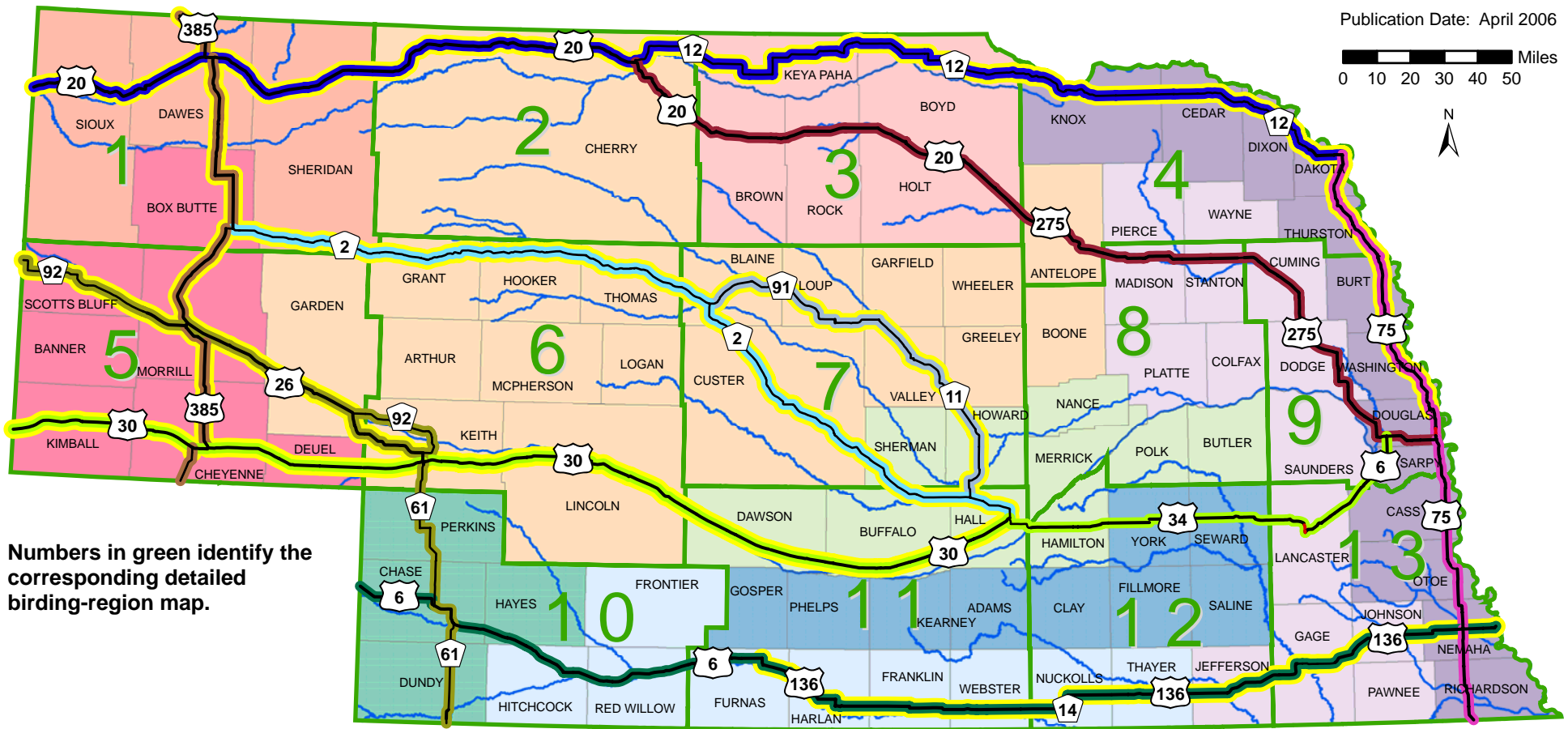
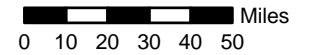


Nebraska's Birding Trails: Index Map
